2. Hand Over Take Over

Final handover-takeover of the books of accounts took some time due to delay in audit reports which was completed in May 2016 and the process for tax clearance and renewal of ABAN registration with CDO office was started. Consequently Tax clearance for the past three years until 2071/72 was completed on September 11, 2016.

3. Meetings with British Council and British Embassy

ABAN executive members occasionally met with Dr. Jovan Ilic, Country Director of the British Council, the first being on September 11, 2015.



4. ABANians in Rescue & Relief of Earthquake Victims

ABAN IPP Shanker Paudel, principal of CVM (Charkhandi Vidya Mandir) Educational Foundation at Gatthaghar Bhaktapur provided shelter for over 300 local people after April 25 and May 12 deadly earthquakes. All the facilities of the newly equipped kinder section were spared for elderly and children seeking rescue after the earthquake.

CVM former students collected funds and relief materials along with medicine; and medical doctors were taken to the affected people in Dolakha district. The school team also visited Dalit village in Changu Narayan area of Bhaktapur district, which was completely damaged by the earthquake. The medical team also distributed relief materials there.

ABAN Executive member Mr. Mahendra Khanal initiated immediate relief to the earthquake victims of Kalika Higher Secondary School of Nagarkot village, Bhaktapur district. The relief program on May 11, 2015 included food distribution to 50 families, medical services to 150 persons with free medicines, food grains, blankets and other relief material. The students of Kalika School were given school uniform, bags and books as well.

5. Publication of Newsletters & Membership Directory 2016

From April 2015 some 14 issues of ABAN Newsletters have been published and electronically distributed to ABAN members and others to keep abreast of ABAN activities regularly. ABAN Membership Directory is an update after 2010 and lists over 400 members (both life and ordinary categories) alphabetically, ID number-wise and in 59 different areas of specialization.



6. Service to Old Age Home

ABAN executive members visited the Center for Service to the Helpless (Nishahaya Sewa Sadan) at Baneshwor on December 26, 2015 and handed over foodstuffs and 25 different types of medicine, as requested by the Center. This is a part of the Association's regular service to the senior citizens in the wake of the cold season that trouble them most.
