The Association of British Alumni in Nepal organized an interactive panel program discussion on September 22 on the Opportunities for Nepalese Nurses to work in the UK at Universal Language & Computer Institute, Kathmandu. Her Excellency Nicolas Pollitt, British Ambassador to Nepal and Dr. Thaneshwor Bhusal, Under Secretary, Ministry of Labor, Employment and Social Security were the panelists on the discussion session moderated by ABAN Past President Mrs. Namrata Sharma.

On August 22, The governments of United Kingdom and Nepal had signed a bilateral agreement on health partnership, opening the door for Nepali nurses to work in the UK.

Under the arrangement, Nepali citizens aged between 20 and 45 years are eligible to apply for the high paying nursing job under the National Health Services in the UK for a term of five years. Nepali citizens will receive the same rights, privileges, protection and dignity as health professionals from the UK, as per the agreement.

The goal of this discussion session is to address key questions about the agreement that interested candidates would have regarding eligibility, application requirements, facilities and other terms of employment under the UK National Health Service.

Her Excellency Nicolas Pollitt addressed the discussion session and also responded as panelist to questions raised from the floor to clarify about the terms of the agreement and the policy of the British government in dealing with the employment of the Nepalese nurses working in the UK.

During the discussion, the panelists clarified that:

- Interested candidate can apply online and try to meet the stringent criteria about qualification, experience, English language proficiency etc.
- There will be an Orientation program to facilitate the candidate understand all the terms and conditions of employment in the UK. This is a zero cost process because this is a government to government arrangement with cost in Nepal or in the UK,
- The selected candidate will have to undergo a certain test before joining the job in the UK. They are eligible to take along their spouse as per the family rules of the British government, although the government of Nepal deals only with the candidate.
- 4. After 5 years they can return to Nepal or opt to settle as per rule.

Past President Mr. Uttam Pant thanked the distinguished panelists and the moderator for their valuable contributions in the panel discussion, and said UK and Nepal have gone a long way in terms of diplomatic ties and relationships. UK is indeed the first country to have Nepal's diplomatic relation. Over the years, many Nepalese have gone to UK for higher education and training, and returned to make valuable contributions to the Nepalese society. ABAN is positive about this agreement to recruit Nepali Nurses for health sector in UK. ABAN will document and create information booklet to highlight the journeys of Nepali people who went to the UK for higher education and training.

Immediate Past President Mr. Maheswor Bhakta Shrestha had welcomed the participants and highlighted the program details. He said ABAN is an Association of British Alumni gathered together for the past two decades to discuss, finds ways and contribute their knowledge and skill gained in the UK for the overall development of Nepal. The Association is a great resource for talents in some 60 different areas of expertise that the Alumni members have gained in the UK. We in ABAN are particularly happy about the growing bilateral ties between Nepal and the UK to strengthen the long-standing relations of over 200 years so happily existing between our countries.



A Prayer Session to Mark the Funeral of Britain's Queen Elizabeth II



On September 19 His Majesty's Ambassador to Nepal HE Nicolas Pollitt addressed a gathering in White Monastery, Boudha and initiated lighting the butter lamp in commemoration of State Funeral of Her Maiestv Queen Elizabeth II. The monks, other invited guests and representatives also lit butter lamps for Her Majesty.



The monks of the monastery began prayers for about 20 minutes, followed by one minute of silence and reflection on the solemnity of the day.

Queen Elizabeth II is very much remembered for her love to Nepal with her royal visits in 1961 and after 25 vears in 1986.

An Anglican funeral service was performed in the Westminster Abbey in London that day in the presence of leaders of all faiths from around the world. The ceremony closed with the national anthem: "God Save the King", symbolizing the transition from one reign to another and a Scottish piper played the lament "Sleep, dearie, sleep".

Nepal National Education Conference



The Conference was led by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology and supported by the School Sector Development Plan – Technical Assistance Programme, a project funded by the European Union and Asian Development Bank and implemented by the British Council.

The conference brought together several key members of the government, teachers and educators specialised in language training to discuss the future and delivery of quality education in Nepal. The event consisted of multiple presentations on mechanisms to support teachers and the roles of leadership, governance, and equity in education.

After Shakshyam: Quality Education, Quality School project was implemented three years back in Kawasoti Municipality some of the significant impacts we have seen are: 98 per cent of students have passed in English, Govt. School enrolment increased by 4500 students, 5000 students have benefitted from the programme and teachers feel confident using innovative ways of teaching.

Dan Bahadur Mahato, English Teacher from Kawasoti Municipality shares the changes he can bring in his teaching styles due to the training he has attended.

MoU on Girls Empowerment Project



An MoU was signed with Voluntary Service Overseas (VSO Nepal) to jointly design, develop and deliver Girls Empowerment and Mainstreaming Sustainability (GEMS) Project. The project aims to enhance the enabling policy environment for a gender-responsive and inclusive education system, improve the self-efficacy and life skills of marginalized adolescent girls and enhance agency, networks, and collaboration for enabling girls to claim their rights.

VSO Nepal and British Council have completed English and Digital for Girls Education, a four-year project in the past. EDGE project has also been shortlisted for 'The 21st Century Learning Award' Bett Asia Awards.
